RE: ROAD SENSE

The roads are the main worry in relation to child safety. There is an approach to road safety which we try to instil in all the children. This is to help them both in and out of school.

Cars should obey lights but they sometimes don't.

We ask you to make sure of this by instilling the same point.

Do not bolt across the road just because the light is green.

With little ones, the main point is **only cross when the teacher says so.**

With older ones, we teach them not to depend entirely on the green light. Sometimes drivers drive through when their lights are red.

We say:

**Before you cross,
WAIT for the green light -
then CHECK the traffic.**

**If the cars are stopping, cross.
If not, don't.**

It's better to be late than run over.
