

STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES REQUIREMENTS

A school must have processes in place that enable it to plan for, and achieve improvement in, student learning outcomes.

Sch2 Clause 2 of the Education & Training Reform Act Regulations 2007

FCS will have appropriate processes in place to support all its students to progress towards and achieve the learning outcomes normally expected for its student cohort, and for the school to plan and achieve improvements in those learning outcomes.

A school must ensure that:

- 1. There is ongoing assessment, monitoring and recording of each student's performance at the school; and
- 2. Each parent of a student enrolled at the school and the student has access to accurate information about the student's performance at the school.

The access to the information must include at least two written reports, relating to the student's performance, from the school to the parent in each year of enrolment of the student.

Sch3 Clause 3 of the Education & Training Reform Act Regulations 2007

FCS will ensure ongoing assessment, monitoring and recording of all students' performance and to report on performance, in writing, to parents and guardians at least twice a year.

All approved authorities must ensure that their schools participate in the national student assessments such as annual literacy and numeracy testing and in any sample assessments for which a school is selected. These include student assessments that are part of Australia's National Assessment Program and any other student assessments as agreed by education ministers in the Education Council. (Section 77(2)(c) of the Australian Education Act 2013 and Regulation 43)

FCS will participate in all activities associated with the National Assessment Program.



FCS will provide ACARA with all the data required for the collection, management, analysis, evaluation and reporting of statistical and related information about educational outcomes.

FCS will meet all the requirements for student reporting as outlined by the Commonwealth Government.

FCS will use the data collected to:

- · Monitor student outcomes
- Analyse and use the data to set goals and targets for outcomes, including for students at risk.
